## FOGO bin

Where does it go? All food waste and organic waste will be turned into compost to be used locally.

### Yes



✓ Fruit and vegetable scraps; e.g. onion, garlic and citrus




✓ Meat, bones, seafood and egg shells



✓ Lawn clippings, weeds, leaves, small plants and roses



✓ Bark and sawdust



✓ Dairy products; e.g. cheese, yogurt and butter



**! IMPORTANT:** Certified Compostable is different to biodegradable. Always look for these symbols on packaging. If it doesn't have them, it doesn't go in FOGO.



✓ Pizza boxes and food-soiled paper



✓ Coffee grounds and tea leaves



✓ Wooden icy pole sticks, toothpicks and cold ash



✓ Used paper towel, tissues and shredded paper



✓ Bread, pasta and cereals



✓ Cooked and uncooked food

### No

- ✗ No plastic bags. **Use compostable liners only**
- ✗ General waste and liquids
- ✗ Fruit stickers and labels
- ✗ Plastic bags and soft plastics (e.g. cling wrap)
- ✗ Magazines, catalogues and waxed paper
- ✗ Coffee pods, coffee cups
- ✗ Nappies, incontinence products and aids
- ✗ Baby wipes
- ✗ Non compostable kitty litters



## Recycling bin

Where does it go? All recyclables will be sent to local processors for recycling.

### Yes



✓ Paper, newspapers, office paper, magazines and envelopes



✓ Cardboard boxes, egg cartons and cereal boxes



✓ Aluminium and steel tins, cans, aerosols and foil (scrunched)



✓ Long-life packaging and cartons



✓ Rigid plastics (lids removed)

### No

- ✗ Bagged recyclables – items must be loose
- ✗ Plastic bags, soft plastics
- ✗ Polystyrene or foam
- ✗ Light globes
- ✗ Glass and ceramics
- ✗ Food waste
- ✗ Garden waste
- ✗ Clothing, shoes and textiles
- ✗ Syringes and sharps
- ✗ Electrical/E-waste




## General waste bin

Where does it go? All general waste that can't be composted or recycled will go to a local landfill facility.

### Yes



✓ Polystyrene and foam



✓ Nappies and personal hygiene items (wrapped)




✓ Household rubbish



✓ Broken glassware, crockery and mirrors



✓ Damaged and old shoes, clothing and textiles



✓ Soft plastics

✓ Any items that can't go in your FOGO, glass-only and recycling bins

### No

- ✗ Garden waste
- ✗ Food waste
- ✗ Glass
- ✗ Paints and solvents
- ✗ Pesticides, oils and chemicals
- ✗ Building materials
- ✗ Recyclable items
- ✗ Electrical/e-waste
- ✗ Syringes and sharps



## Glass-only bin

Where does it go? All glass is sent to a local processor for recycling or repurposing.

### Yes



✓ Glass bottles – wine, beer and spirits, olive oil bottles, etc.



✓ Glass jars and containers – jam, pasta sauce, condiments, etc.

### No

- ✗ General waste
- ✗ Lids and bottle caps
- ✗ Light globes, mirrors, perfume bottles, drinking glasses and window glass
- ✗ Ceramics
- ✗ Pyrex containers
- ✗ Cigarette butts
- ✗ Plastic bags
