## Sister City Relationship Action Plan

The aim of the action plan is to promote and enhance the Sister City relationship.

In addition to the official actions outlined below, Tokai City Council and Macedon Ranges Council will commit to continue to identify activities, common to the needs of our communities, which can generate new initiatives to further economic, social and cultural exchange. Activities will be implemented annually through mutual discussion and agreement, aligned with respective budgetary processes.
