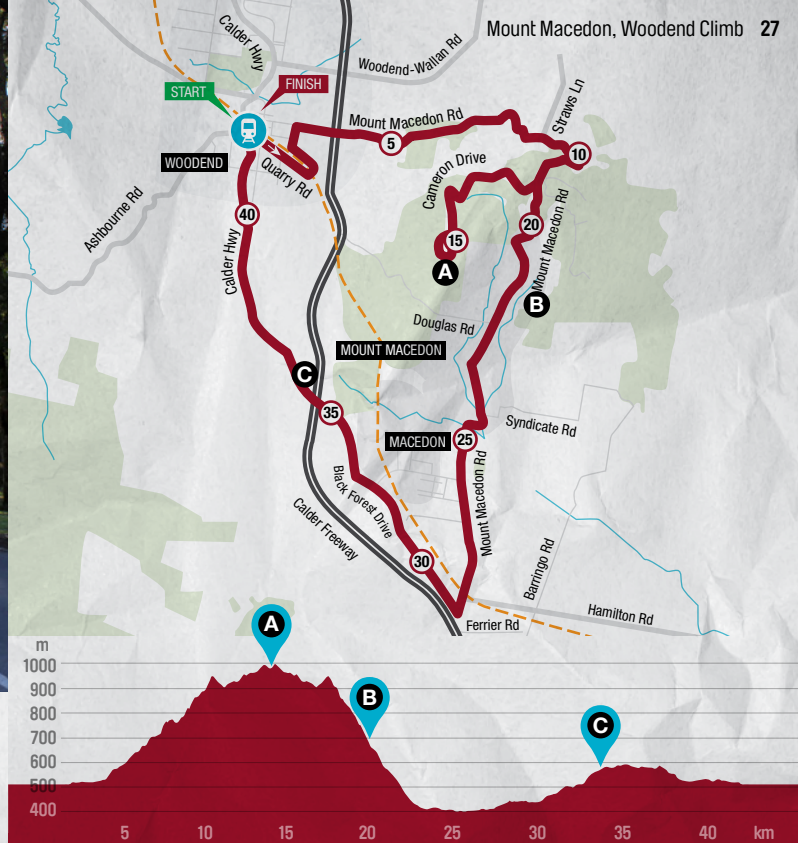

Mount Macedon is naturally one of the highlights of the region. The northern side is considered the 'easier' of the two ascents but still a real challenge, even for the well rounded rider. As you make your way up the the climb, you are transported to another world as you navigate the winding roads through this lush forest. The views from the Memorial Cross are spectacular and tree lined roads take you back through the quaint township and outskirts of Macedon back to Woodend.
