Child supervision policy

It is a condition of entry to all Macedon Ranges Shire Council aquatic facilities that -

Children 0yo-4yo

- Will be accompanied into the facility and supervised by an adult at a ratio of no greater than 2 children per adult supervisor.
- Will have an adult within arm's reach of them at all times whilst within a body of water.

Children 5yo-9yo

- Will be accompanied into the facility and supervised by an adult at a ratio of no greater than 10 children per adult supervisor.
- Will be actively supervised via line of sight at all times whilst within a body of water.



General

- No child under the age of 10 years will be admitted entry into this facility unless accompanied and supervised by an adult for the duration of their stay.
- Failure to adhere to the above conditions of entry will result in the child/children being removed from the water and returned to their supervising adult.
- Staff reserve the right to remove a child from a body of water or request a child use a body of water which is more suited to their aquatic abilities if they deem that child to be a risk to themselves or others.
