Additional notes

Use this form to apply for enrolment on the Council voters' roll if you are the owner of a rateable property in the Council area.

To qualify for the voters' roll as an owner, you much meet the following requirements:

- must be at least 18 years of age on or before election day,
- must be an owner of a rateable property in the Council's municipal area, and
- must not be enrolled as a resident of the municipality on the State electoral roll.

No more than 2 owners and 2 occupiers can be enrolled for a single rateable property. Contact the Council for further assistance if there are people already enrolled for the property.

You can only enrol once in a municipality, regardless of the number of properties you own or occupy.

It is important to note that your enrolment remains in force for as long as you own the property, or don't otherwise become enrolled as a resident in the municipality on the State roll. You may resign this enrolment by application to the Council.

Australian citizen: You citizenship does not affect your entitlement to enrol as an owner ratepayer. If you are an Australian citizen and you live within the Council, you may already be enrolled as a resident on the state electoral roll.

Once you are enrolled, it is compulsory to vote under section 266 of the *Local Government Act* 2020. Failure to vote may result in an infringement fine equal to 0.5 penalty units.

For this application to be effective, it must be received by Council no later than the close of the roll.

Voters' rolls distributed by VEC will not include dates of birth. Failure to provide requested information may mean that a person cannot be enrolled or vote in Council elections. A person may access their personal information, held in the Council's enrolment records, by making a request in writing to the Chief Executive Officer of the Council.
