The framework for supporting community education in diversity of ability and acceptance of all abilities is always more successful when our children are taught those skills from an early age. Hence, it is great to see this embedded in the plan for kindergartens and child care centres thought the teaching of Auslan and key word sign.

From a service provider perspective and resident of the Macedon Ranges:-

Our central shopping centre is by and large accessible for those with varying mobility issues. The limitation occurs when entering into the premises of some of the smaller store owners. This is particularly the case on the Atkin street shopping strip. Someone with a walking frame or wheelchair will not be able to mobilise comfortably or enter in some stores.

Future development & upgrade of the commercial centre of Gisborne would benefit from ensuring all footpaths are level and not paved; threshold ramps instead of steps; height of door handles for easy opening; tactile and other indicators for people with vision impairment.

The MRSC web page could benefit from an upgraded to be more accessible for any person with cognitive impairment; forms available in 'easy read' format – 'Board Maker' or 'Compic' style images and simple sentences.
